# What Quality Means in Foreign Filings



### **Insights from IP Professionals at INTA 2025**


At INTA 2025, Azami asked attendees a simple but powerful question:

"When you think about quality in the foreign filing process, what does that mean to you?" Respondents selected their top two priorities from a list of six key themes.

Their answers reveal how IP professionals define quality in today's complex, high-stakes global filing environment—and where they expect their partners to deliver.

## **Key Findings – Top Priorities**

- Translations reflect the intent
- Costs & local requirements are clear
- Process feels smooth
- Prosecution is handled reliably

## Quality starts at the source

 Translation accuracy and cost clarity are foundational markers of a quality filing experience critical to confidence and compliance

## Execution matters — but so does fit

- A smooth, familiar process and reliable post-filing support ranked highly
- Quality is also about how easily global filings integrate into existing workflows and continue through prosecution

# Reputation is a quality metric

- How their firm or company is perceived matters
- Quality is not just technical—it's relational

## **Most Commonly Paired Priorities**

While individual choices reveal what matters most, paired selections uncover how IP professionals **experience quality as a system** — not a single outcome.

The most common pairings were:

#### • Predictability is paramount

Cost transparency showed up in three of the five most common combinations, often paired with either **technical accuracy** or **workflow simplicity.** This reinforces that clients need more than good results—they need to **see them coming.** 

#### Start strong, finish strong.

Pairings between **translations** and **prosecution** reflect concern for consistency across the entire process—from first draft to final grant.

#### Reputation travels with reliability.

The pairing of **prosecution handling** with **client-facing quality** suggests that downstream reliability is deeply tied to brand trust
